History


Herzing University is a private, regionally accredited nonprofit institution of higher learning founded in 1965. Herzing is committed to the education, training and advancement of career-focused individuals.

Mission

Timely and Relevant Curriculum

Herzing has proven that they are a leader in meeting the demands of nursing education. Herzing offers a Master of Science in Nursing-Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (MSN-PMHNP) program which is offered online and CCNE accredited.* Telemedicine is threaded throughout the program curriculum to ensure that students understand the benefits and functionality of remote care services, and the opportunity to improve access to care by using this delivery method. According to the American Psychiatric Nurses Association¹, more than 75% of all U.S. counties have a shortage of mental health workers while 20% of adults experience a mental health condition in any given year. A Kaiser Family Foundation poll from April 2020¹¹ found that nearly half of adults in the country reported their mental health had been negatively affected by the pandemic.

How Herzing is Helping to Solve the Nursing Shortage

Herzing University's goal is to become the largest provider of nursing graduates in the state of Wisconsin to help solve the urgent nursing shortage. In 2023, Herzing had over 1,000 students enrolled within the state of Wisconsin who plan to graduate with a healthcare or nursing degree. With 11 campuses regionally and a national Online platform, Herzing boasts more than 12,000 total healthcare alumni. Herzing specializes in educating local students, who already have deep roots in the communities we serve and plan to stay living and contributing to the area long after graduation.

Adaptive Learning

Herzing is taking advantage of Adaptive Learning's innovative technology, Herzing truly is a leader in online education. Adaptive Learning is baked into the online learning platform delivering general education courses to Herzing students. The platform evaluates each students' needs and helps them master content where they are "weaker" and spend less time on content where they are already strong. It's much more complicated than this but ask us how adaptive learning is helping students move through coursework and stay on track for graduation.

Herzing CARE Clinics

The Herzing University CARE Clinic is a pro bono facility that provides wellness and therapeutic services through the Physical Therapist Assistant program at Herzing University-Brookfield. Under the direction and supervision of Herzing faculty, our clinic serves clients with no insurance and those who are either underinsured or have exhausted their insurance benefits.



Community Involvement

At Herzing University, we believe volunteering can be a valuable way for students to develop new skills and give back to their communities. It also builds character and instills a sense of purpose beyond students' academic and personal lives.

Many Herzing academic programs have public service and volunteer work built into their curriculums. In fact, the Dental Hygiene and Physical Therapist Assistant students even work with patients in Herzing's own community-based clinics. The Dental Hygiene clinic in Minneapolis provides free dental screenings and cleanings to the public, in exchange, students can fulfill the required hours of patient interaction through the clinic. Similarly, the CARES Clinic in Brookfield currently sees over 300 patients per year and offers physical therapy services to community members who either hold no insurance or have reached their maximum insurance benefits but still require therapy care.

Whether it's teaming up with Habitat for Humanity to build homes for local families or its ground-breaking partnership with Children's Hospital to provide scholarships for children who have aged out of the foster care system, Herzing is committed to exerting a positive influence on the communities we serve.

Herzing Dental Hygiene Clinics

The Herzing University Dental Hygiene Clinic in Minneapolis provides low cost dental hygiene care to people who lack adequate insurance to cover basic dental needs. Current students, faculty and staff are seen free of cost, a senior discount is offered for most services for patients 60 years old and older. Work is performed by Herzing dental hygiene students who are supervised by licensed hygiene faculty and a licensed faculty dentist.
