### **Commencement Speaker**



Nayef A. Murbarak, Esq. Mubarak Law, Orlando, Florida

Nayef A. Mubarak is a trilingual (Arabic, English, and Spanish) lifelong resident of Central Florida who earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Central Florida. Mr. Mubarak spent time working as a mutual fund accountant with the Bank of New York prior to enrolling and completing law school at Barry University College of Law. He was admitted to the Florida Bar in 2010 and was a partner at a well-known Orlando firm prior to opening his own office in August 2016, Mubarak Law, a full-service

immigration and personal injury law firm. Nayef's practice focuses on investor visas, waivers, employment, and family-based petitions.

Nayef was invited to the White House in 2013 for "Strategy Meeting with Arab-American Community Leaders" to discuss immigration reform. He served as the chair of the Immigration & Naturalization Executive Committee for the Orange County Bar Association (2020). In 2019, he was elected as the Orlando Regional Vice-Chair of the American Immigration Lawyers Association (AILA), which he held for two consecutive terms. Nayef has appeared on numerous local and national news outlets as a legal analyst for immigration law. He was listed as one of Orlando's 40 top executives under 40 by the Orlando Business Journal in 2020. In 2021, he also served as Chair of the ICE-Liaison committee of AILA CFC. In 2023, Mr. Mubarak has reprised his position as the Orlando Regional Vice Chair for AILA CF.

With his vast experience in immigration law, Attorney Mubarak has been invited to speak at numerous conferences throughout the State of Florida and nationally where he lectured on nuanced law topics. He has appeared more than a dozen times nationally and internationally to commentate on compelling immigration law changes and updates.

Attorney Nayef Mubarak is committed to serving his community. He served as a director for the Arab American Community Center from 2013-2019, and the Arab American Citizenship Advisory board for the Orange County Sheriff from 2013-017. Nayef volunteers monthly with these organizations offering free consultations and citizenship clinics. He also now serves on the executive board for the Orlando Center of Justice which provides pro-bono and low-bono services for victims of domestic violence and indigent committees.

m = Magna Cum Laude (with high honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.70-3.89 is recognized by a double gold cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

c = Cum Laude (with honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.50-3.69 is recognized by a double silver cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

#### Associate Degree and Diploma Honors

h = Honors A cumulative grade point average of 3.50 to 4.00. is recognized by double white cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

#### Alpha Beta Kappa National Honor Society (ABK)

† = ABK National Honor Society

Alpha Beta Kappa National Honor Society membership is open to undergraduate students who have a grade point average of 3.75 or higher and are recognized at commencement by wearing red, white and blue honor cords. Additional qualifications for membership include leadership and service in class and school activities, and personal integrity and good moral character.
