Hanne-Lore Gambrell Founder and Managing Partner The Law Office of H. Gambrell

While pursuing her JD/MBA from The University of Akron School of Law and The University of Akron College of Business Administration, respectively, Hanne-Lore was an Associate Editor for the Akron Law Review. She also served as President of The University of Akron's Chapter of Black Law Students Association from 2016-2018, winning National BLSA's Small Chapter of the Year for the 2017-2018 academic year; and Chief of Staff for the Midwest Region of National Black Law Students Association where

she assisted with coordinating the 2018 MWBLSA Regional Conference in St. Louis, MO. Hanne-Lore also volunteered with the Inmate Assistance Program, where she assisted inmates at Summit County Jail with legal research issues; volunteered as a Student Ambassador with The University of Akron School of Law; and with several other student organizations, including Student Bar Association and the American Constitution Society. Hanne-Lore received student of the year award in 2018 from the Akron-Canton Barristers Association. In 2020 she was awarded the 30 for the Future award by the Greater Akron Chamber.

Hanne-Lore has been practicing law since 2018 and is an active member of various bar associations. Hanne-Lore has recently had the opportunity to contribute to a brief reviewed by the Ohio Supreme Court, has won multiple settlements, won a judgment in favor of her client at her first civil jury trial, and argued her first case in the 9th District Court of Appeals in January 2024.

Hanne-Lore serves as a chair of the Social Action Committee for the Akron Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. She also is a board member and chair of the Governance Committee for OPEN M. Hanne-Lore is also a 2023 Ohio State Bar Association Fellow, where she and her classmates are working on creating a symposium to educate legal professionals all over the state of Ohio on Trauma Informed Lawyering. Hanne-Lore is also a life member of the Akron Canton Barristers Association.

Hanne-Lore's past board services includes serving as a past President of the Akron Urban League Young Professionals and past chair of the Diversity Committee at the Akron Bar Association, where she also served as a board member from 2019-2022. Hanne-Lore was a past board member of North Hill CDC from 2020-2023, a mentor for Black Women Bosses at Kent State University, and has founded an African American Attorney's mentorship program at The University of Akron School of Law. Hanne-Lore has also served as an Adjunct Professor at the University of Akron School of Law. She loves to volunteer in her spare time with various community organizations and is an avid reader.

Commencement Speaker



Shammas Malik Mayor of Akron, Ohio

Born and raised in Akron, Mayor Shammas Malik knows that people are what makes our city special.

Growing up in Northwest Akron, Mayor Malik learned about the importance of public service from his mom, Dr. Helen Qammar, who taught chemical engineering at the University of Akron. To her, life was about finding something you enjoy, and using it to give back to others. She also taught her son the im-

portance of education and hard work. Those values, as well as the International Baccalaureate program at Firestone High School, helped Mayor get a scholarship to The Ohio State University and then the opportunity to attend Harvard Law School.

After finishing law school, Mayor Malik decided to come back home, to serve Akron like his mother. Since moving home in 2016, Mayor Malik has been dedicated to public service, first as an Assistant Director of Law for the city, and then as the elected representative to City Council for Ward 8. As a city lawyer, he gained a first-hand understanding of every department in city government.

In 2019, Mayor Malik successfully ran for Akron City Council in the neighborhood where he grew up. As a councilmember, he worked tirelessly to serve the people of Akron in real, everyday ways that impact their lives. In September of 2022, he announced he was running for Mayor.

Mayor Malik believes deeply that for our city to have a successful future, we must change how our city government works – creating a city hall that is more open, more responsive, and more collaborative. He knows that if every one of the 190,000 residents of this city feels heard, we can get folks energized and empowered to be a part of real community-based solutions so everyone feels safe in their neighborhoods, so students can thrive in school, and so young people from Akron can build an amazing life without leaving home.

Mayor Malik was sworn in as Akron's 63rd Mayor on Jan. 1, 2024. He is Akron's youngest Mayor and first Mayor of color. His platform focuses on key initiatives which make up his Together for Akron plan: a unifying vision for our city's future, rooted in safe neighborhoods, good schools, affordable homes, equitable economic opportunity, and environmental sustainability. Through all of these initiatives, Mayor Malik is dedicated to communication and transparency as pillars of his administration.

Renée succeeded her father, Henry Herzing, as president of the Herzing University System on March 1st, 2009. After attaining a bachelor's degree from Brown University, she taught abroad in Scotland and Germany for nine years before completing her Masters in Business Administration.

She has worked in various positions at Herzing University at the campus level, including registrar, director of admissions, and president of Herzing University online. In addition, Ms. Herzing has overseen the System's online, strategic planning, and information technology initiatives. She launched the System's Online division in 2003, which has grown from 100 students to over 2500 students.

In education, she is on the Steering Committee of the Higher Education Regional Alliance (HERA), the Board of WAICU (Wisconsin Association of Independent Colleges and Universities), and a Trustee of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Milwaukee. Renée served on the Board of Directors for the Career Education Colleges and Universities (CECU) and was the Chair of its Grassroots Committee. Additionally, she is active in national educational idea-sharing groups.

In the business community, she is a member of YPO (Young Presidents' Organization), an international organization of over 20,000 CEOs, where she has held a variety of leadership roles since 2011. She is also a member of the Greater Milwaukee Committee (GMC), on the Steering Committee of Milwaukee Women, Inc. and a member of TEMPO Milwaukee.

Outside of work, Renée enjoys playing rock music in a band with her husband and son, traveling, entertaining, learning languages, and spending as much time as possible with her two teenage children, including horseback riding with her daughter.



Bachelor Degree Honors

s = Summa Cum Laude (with greatest honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.90-4.00 is recognized by a gold stole that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

m = Magna Cum Laude (with high honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.70-3.89 is recognized by a double gold cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

c = Cum Laude (with honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.50-3.69 is recognized by a double silver cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

Associate Degree and Diploma Honors

h = Honors A cumulative grade point average of 3.50 to 4.00. is recognized by double white cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

Alpha Beta Kappa National Honor Society (ABK)

† = ABK National Honor Society

Alpha Beta Kappa National Honor Society membership is open to undergraduate students who have a grade point average of 3.75 or higher and are recognized at commencement by wearing red, white and blue honor cords. Additional qualifications for membership include leadership and service in class and school activities, and personal integrity and good moral character. The purpose of the society is to help schools, colleges and universities how-so-ever organized and named, and their students and alumni through the encouragement and recognition of superior academic work and laboratory training in honorable fields of endeavor.

Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing (STT)

 Σ = STT International Honor Society

Induction into the Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing is open to undergraduate nursing students who have completed one half of their nursing curriculum, achieved academic excellence demonstrated by a GPA of 3.0 and rank in the upper 35% of their class; membership is open to graduate nursing students who have completed one quarter of their program and have achieved academic excellence demonstrated by a GPA of 3.5. Students are recognized at commencement by wearing purple and white honor cords or stole. The society is an international community of nurses, dedicated to the advancement of knowledge, teaching, learning, and service through the cultivation of communities of practice, education, and research. Members include clinical nurses and administrators, academic nurse educators and researchers, policymakers, entrepreneurs, and others working to fulfill the organization's vision of connected, empowered nurse leaders transforming global healthcare.
