

Renée Herzing University President Herzing University

Renée succeeded her father, Henry Herzing, as president of the Herzing University System on March 1st, 2009. After attaining a bachelor's degree from Brown University, she taught abroad in Scotland and Germany for nine years before completing her Masters in Business Administration.

She has worked in various positions at Herzing University at the campus level, including registrar, director of admissions, and president of Herzing University online. In addition, Ms. Herzing has overseen the System's online, strategic planning, and information technology initiatives. She launched the System's Online division in 2003, which has grown from 100 students to over 2500 students.

In education, she is on the Steering Committee of the Higher Education Regional Alliance (HERA), the Board of WAICU (Wisconsin Association of Independent Colleges and Universities), and a Trustee of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Milwaukee. Renée served on the Board of Directors for the Career Education Colleges and Universities (CECU) and was the Chair of its Grassroots Committee. Additionally, she is active in national educational idea-sharing groups.

In the business community, she is a member of YPO (Young Presidents' Organization), an international organization of over 20,000 CEOs, where she has held a variety of leadership roles since 2011. She is also a member of the Greater Milwaukee Committee (GMC), on the Steering Committee of Milwaukee Women, Inc. and a member of TEMPO Milwaukee.

Outside of work, Renée enjoys playing rock music in a band with her family, traveling, entertaining, learning languages, and spending as much time as possible with her two teenage children, including horseback riding with her daughter.

Judge David Hamilton Administrative/Presiding Judge Akron Municipal Court

David Hamilton was born and raised in Akron. He is a graduate of Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy (CVCA) and received his Bachelor of Arts in Sociology as well as minors in Criminal Justice and Criminology from the University of Akron. David earned his Juris Doctorate at the Western Michigan University's Thomas M. Cooley School of Law.

David is a former Prosecutor and Judicial Attorney in Akron Municipal Court. He also served as the District 5 Summit County Councilman. As the Chair

of Public Safety David started and spearheaded the Summit County Jail Advisory Commission in 2017. David is also the founder of the MY-STARS Summer Youth Enrichment Camp; designed for youth to gain exposure to "real world" skills and experiences needed for success in future planning for school and life. David also started the Greater Akron Small Business Summit, which is a network for start-up small businesses in Summit County to learn about the resources that are available to them.

David is currently serving his second term as the Akron Municipal Court Judge. In 2023 and 2025, David was selected by his peers to serves as the Administrative/Presiding Judge of the Akron Municipal Court.

David created COMPASS, which is a program geared towards helping young men find their way by providing opportunities for accountability and change. David is also the co-creator of Raising the Bar, which is a court sponsored program in partnership with Summit County Executive Ilene Shapiro, geared toward creating a pipeline from high school to law school by creating opportunities for minority high school students. He is passionate about inspiring the next generation of attorneys and serves as an Adjunct Professor at The University of Akron School of Law.

David is involved in many civic and non-profit organizations. He is a former Board Member of Victim Assistance and AxessPointe Community Health Centers, Summit County Land Bank, The First Tee of Greater Akron and the Akron Zoo. David was appointed to the Ohio Supreme Court Commission on Professionalism in 2023 and currently serves on the Board of Directors for ArtsNow. He is a graduate of Leadership Ohio Class of 2023 and a Class 34 Graduate of Leadership Akron. Leadership Ohio honored David with their Community Impact Award in 2024.

David was awarded the Harold K. Stubbs Humanitarian Award, The Akron Bar Association Diversity Award, the BMe Genius fellowship, Crain's Cleveland Business Forty under 40, the Greater Akron Chamber's 30 for the Future award, the Omicron Delta Kappa Alumni Award from the University of Akron and the Akron Urban League Rising Star Award.

David is passionate about helping people and it is his desire to give back to his community.

Heather Evans Nurse Manager Cleveland Clinic Associate of Science in Nursing, 2008

Heather is a distinguished nursing leader whose career reflects an unwavering commitment to quality and patient-centered care. She began her journey in healthcare after earning her Associate Degree in Nursing from Herzing College in 2008. Soon after, she joined Regency Hospital, where her dedication and clinical skill quickly earned her a pro-

motion to Charge Nurse in 2010. In pursuit of advanced critical care experience, she transitioned to the ICU at Mercy Hospital in Canton in 2013.

From 2016 to 2017, Heather expanded her professional horizons as a travel nurse in the ICU at the Cleveland Clinic Ashtabula Medical Center. Her leadership trajectory continued at University Hospitals from 2017 to 2019, where she served as Assistant Nurse Manager. There, she led the expansion of ICU capacity from 8 to 16 beds and played a key role in the hospital's first mobile ECMO transfer from UH Portage to the main campus. Her collaboration with LifeBank to enhance organ donation training further exemplified her dedication to quality improvement and staff development.

Since 2019, Heather has served as Nurse Manager at Cleveland Clinic Akron General. She has championed the implementation of selfmanaged nursing teams and improved patient satisfaction through structured bedside reporting and hourly rounding. During the COVID-19 pandemic, she was instrumental in helping design and operate a dedicated COVID-19 ICU and mentored staff in launching a secondary stroke unit, demonstrating agility and leadership during a time of crisis. Heather's educational achievements underscore her commitment to lifelong learning and healthcare leadership. She earned her BSN in 2016, her Master of Healthcare Administration (MHA) in 2018, and most recently, her Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) in 2024, all from Ohio University.

Continuing her mission to enhance community wellness, Heather and her husband are currently in the process of opening an IV hydration business, scheduled to launch in June 2025. This new venture reflects her passion for innovative, accessible care beyond the hospital setting. With a career defined by excellence, innovation, and compassion, Heather exemplifies what it means to be a truly distinguished alumna in nursing.

Bachelor Degree Honors

s = Summa Cum Laude (with greatest honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.90-4.00 is recognized by a gold stole that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

m = Magna Cum Laude (with high honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.70-3.89 is recognized by a double gold cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

c = Cum Laude (with honor) A cumulative grade point average of 3.50-3.69 is recognized by a double silver cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

Associate Degree and Diploma Honors

h = Honors A cumulative grade point average of 3.50 to 4.00. is recognized by double white cord that is part of the graduate's academic regalia.

Alpha Beta Kappa National Honor Society (ABK)

† = ABK National Honor Society

Alpha Beta Kappa National Honor Society membership is open to undergraduate students who have a grade point average of 3.75 or higher and are recognized at commencement by wearing red, white and blue honor cords. Additional qualifications for membership include leadership and service in class and school activities, and personal integrity and good moral character. The purpose of the society is to help schools, colleges and universities how-so-ever organized and named, and their students and alumni through the encouragement and recognition of superior academic work and laboratory training in honorable fields of endeavor.

Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing (STT)

Induction into the Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing is open to undergraduate nursing students who have completed one half of their nursing curriculum, achieved academic excellence demonstrated by a GPA of 3.0 and rank in the upper 35% of their class; membership is open to graduate nursing students who have completed one quarter of their program and have achieved academic excellence demonstrated by a GPA of 3.5. Students are recognized at commencement by wearing purple and white honor cords or stole. The society is an international community of nurses, dedicated to the advancement of knowledge, teaching, learning, and service through the cultivation of communities of practice, education, and research. Members include clinical nurses and administrators, academic nurse educators and researchers, policymakers, entrepreneurs, and others working to fulfill the organization's vision of connected, empowered nurse leaders transforming global healthcare.
