To achieve this, all proposed research projects by Herzing University students, faculty, or staff must be submitted to the Institutional Review Board (IRB) for review and approval.

Submitting your research for IRB review is a requirement of Herzing University policy. Whether you are an experienced researcher or conducting your first study, this site provides the resources you need to prepare your project for IRB review. Our goal is to help you conduct research ethically and responsibly.

Getting Started

- Complete the appropriate IRB application and submit it to irb@herzing.edu.
 - o DNE and DNP students should complete the Herzing University IRB Healthcare Improvement or Innovation Project Application.
 - o Non-DNE/DNP students should complete the Herzing University IRB Research Protocol Application.
- Review the submission checklist on the first page of the application to ensure all required components are included.
- The Herzing University IRB will review your application at an upcoming meeting and notify you of the decision afterward.
