### HEALTHCARE

Herzing's healthcare programs are designed to meet the expanding needs of employers in this fast-growing industry. Focused on direct patient care and administration, study topics include Dental Assisting and Hygiene, Healthcare Management, Health Information Management (including CAHIIM Accredited ASHIM and BSHIM programs), Medical Assisting, Medical Billing and Coding, Medical Office Administration, Nursing (including CCNE-accredited\* BSN and MSN programs), Physical Therapist Assistant, Surgical Technology, Occupational Therapy Assistant and more. Most programs prepare graduates for industry-specialized certifications.

### TECHNOLOGY
